





The Ringling Brothers and Barnum & Bailey had nothing on the show put on by St. Jerome's as we hosted the ASAA 1A Boys and Girls Basketball Provincials from March 17<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup>. 24 boys and girls teams gathered from across the province to compete for supremacy on the hardwood for schools with less than 100 students in their high schools. The weekend opened with team pictures and practices on Wednesday. Opening ceremonies were hosted in the St. Jerome's gym on Thursday morning. Dignitaries were piped in by local piper Shelly MacDonald, and after a prayer led by Father Adam, local dignitaries welcomed the assembled athletes to Vermilion. Competition began in St. Jerome's and J.R. Robson gyms at 11:00 a.m. All participants gathered at the Vermilion Regional Center for the banquet catered by Sharon Jaremco. We were also treated to a message from former U of A Bears Coach, and three time national champion, Don Horwood. Coach Horwood emphasized the ideals of working hard, setting goals and perseverance to those listening, and highlighted those desirable characteristics with anecdotes gathered over 30 years of coaching. The tournament ended on Saturday evening with the girls and boys final. In the girls final Acme defeated Trochu in a very close game, and in the boys final Livingstone put on a basketball clinic as they defeated Foremost in a very entertaining game. St. Jerome's would like to thank all its volunteers and sponsors for their support as we hosted this tournament. This was the first time that a 1A school had hosted both girls and boys and this was a major undertaking for a small, rural school. Thanks to YOUR support, we put on a show that had the entire tournament singing the praises of our minor officials, our hosts/hostesses, our facilities ... the whole production! 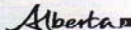
